“IF YOU’RE FEELING WEAK ... THIS IS FOR YOU.”

READ

Acts 2:1-18

The baptism of the Holy Spirit wasn't just an event to inaugurate the church; it was a poured-out blessing. Jesus Himself received this Promise from the Father and poured it out to the church, so we might continue doing what He was doing. One of the last things He said to His followers before He was taken up to heaven was to wait in Jerusalem for the Promise of the Holy Spirit. They were already gloriously saved. They had walked with Him. He told them He had more for them. They waited and prayed, and the Power came and filled the house where they were staying.
